The 2007 campaign was a season of transition for the Georgia State baseball team. Associate head coach Greg Frady took the reins of the program the previous summer, replacing long-time head coach Mike Hurst, who was not in the dugout for the first time since the program was resurrected in 1991. Frady brought in a new coaching staff and did not shy away from tough competition, as the Panthers opened the season on the road with a three-game series against No. 25 Alabama.

The Panthers dropped three to the Crimson Tide. State dropped an 8-2 decision on the road against in-state rival Mercer before finally returning to Panthersville for its home opener against Alabama State.

The Panther offense arose from its slumber to beat the Hornets 16-6 and 20-4, as Frady registered his first wins at the helm. State did not travel far for its next game, taking on cross-town rival and No. 15 Georgia Tech on Feb. 21. The Panthers scored five runs in the second inning to rally for a 9-5 victory on the road.

Following the upset win over Georgia Tech, the Panthers struggled to find consistency and dropped three of their next four contests – including two of three against Indiana State. Georgia State returned to its winning ways when Mississippi Valley State came to Panthersville for a three-game series. The Panthers outscored the Delta Devils 42-11 in a three-game sweep.

Wins over Clark Atlanta at home and on the road against Furman saw State extend its winning streak to five. The Panthers opened their series against Southeastern Louisiana with a victory, giving State a six-game winning streak. After the opening win against SLU, State dropped the final two games of the series.

The Panthers opened Colonial Athletic Association play at home against perennial power UNC Wilmington. Frady's club knocked off the Seahawks in the opening game 5-3, giving the first-year head coach his first career victory against a CAA opponent. State was unable to carry over its success from the opening game, as UNCW took the final two games of the series.

In a midweek rematch against Georgia Tech, nine Panther pitchers combined to one-hit the Yellow Jackets. However, the Jackets only needed one hit to claim a 3-0 win at Panthersville.

Georgia State returned to CAA action the next two weekends, facing George Mason on the road before hosting Delaware. State dropped two against Mason, but took the series 2-1 over Delaware. The Panthers rallied in the seventh inning to defeat in-state foe Mercer 10-8 at Panthersville. A CAA series sweep of William and Mary gave State its second six-game winning streak

of the season, as the Panthers headed into a non-conference contest against Jacksonville State.

The Panthers fell on the road against the Gamecocks, and dropped the first two games of their series against CAA preseason favorite VCU on the road before rallying for a 12-11 win in the finale. State dropped two of three against CAA opponent Northeastern on the road and both contests in a two-game road series against Georgia Southern.

Senior first baseman Charlie Pelt notched his 234th career hit against James Madison on April 27 to take over first place on State's all-time hits list. The Panthers unfortunately dropped two of three against the Dukes. The friendly confines of The Field at Panthersville helped State rebound though, as the Panthers took two of three from Hofstra the following weekend.

On the road against CAA power Old Dominion, State dropped a pair of late-inning 3-2 decisions and took a 7-1 win in the second game of the series. Heading into its final CAA series, State needed a pair of wins against Towson to secure a berth in the conference tournament. After dropping the opener, the Panther offense came alive and provided 5-1 and 9-2 victories to finish the regular season with wins over every league opponent. State finished with a 15-15 record in the CAA and secured the team's second straight berth in the six-team CAA Tournament.

The Panthers had a tough act to follow after State eliminated Old Dominion in the 2006 tournament, as the teams squared off in the 2007 tournament opener. Trailing by three, the sixth-seeded Panthers brought the tying run to the plate in the eighth and ninth innings against the top-seeded Monarchs. Unfortunately, State could not get the big hit and force extra innings, falling 5-2. The Panthers fell 10-2 to George Mason on the second day of the tournament, eliminating State. In the loss to George Mason, junior designated hitter Luke Gordon tied the school record for hits in a season with 77.

Georgia State finished its first season under Frady with a 26-32 overall record, and made tremendous strides with many players receiving recognition for their accomplishments. Gordon became the first Panther to earn First-Team All-CAA accolades while Pelt and outfielder Eric Suttle each collected Second-Team All-CAA honors. Additionally, pitchers Adam Bowling and Will Palmer took home weekly honors during the course of the season. For the second year in a row, junior second baseman Jean-Michel Rochon-Salvas was named to the CoSIDA/ESPN The Magazine District III All-Academic First Team.
