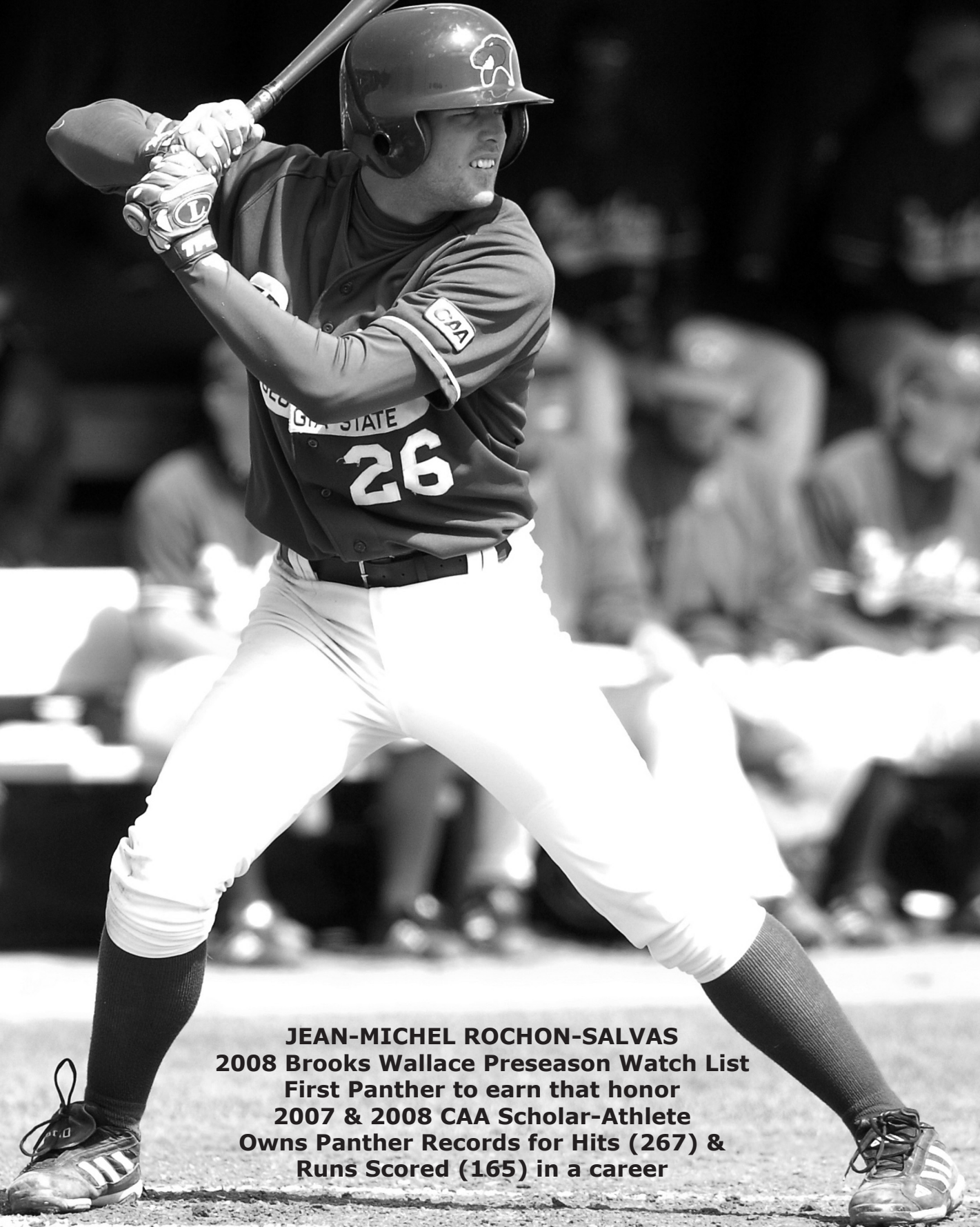


# *2008 Review*

2008 Brooks Wallace Preseason Watch List  
First Panther to earn that honor  
2007 & 2008 CAA Scholar-Athlete  
Owns Panther Records for Hits (267) &  
Runs Scored (165) in a career

The Georgia State baseball team saw several records – both team and individual– eclipsed during the 2008 campaign. The Panthers set team marks for wins, hits and RBIs in a season. Individually, Bradley Logan set the single-season record with 85 hits while Jean-Michel Rochon-Salvas eclipsed the career mark for hits and finished with 267 during his four-year stint as a Panther.

Jean-Michel Rochon-Salvas was named to the Brooks Wallace National Player of the Year Preseason Watch List before the season began, racking up the first of many accolades to come the way of the Panthers during the year.

The Panthers opened the season with an eight-game winning streak, tying the school record set during the 2000 campaign. Head coach Greg Frady's squad took a pair of four-game series from Jackson State and IPFW to tie the mark, and got off to the best start in program history. The Panther offense exploded against Jackson State, scoring 60 runs on 64 hits during the series. Chase Childers was named the first CAA Player of the Week (Feb. 26) after hitting .636 during the week with two doubles, a homer, seven RBIs and seven runs scored.

The State onslaught continued against IPFW, as the Panthers scored in double digits twice in that series and would score in double figures a total of 17 times during the season.

State won nine of its first 10 games before suffering a four-game losing streak with a loss to No. 11 Georgia Tech and a sweep against James Madison, eventual CAA Tournament champion. The Panthers came back to win four in a row, including a sweep of VCU on the road. Will Palmer earned CAA Co-Pitcher of the Week honors after tossing seven shutout innings with eight strikeouts and two hits against VCU. After dropping another decision to cross-town rival Georgia Tech, State won at Mercer and took two of three from Northeastern.

At Mercer, Rochon-Salvas touched home plate for the 138th time in his career to have scored more runs than any other player in Panther history. During the series against Northeastern, Bobby Bennett made his 69th career appearance on the mound to break Brock Radaer's school record.

After splitting its rain-shortened series with William & Mary at home, State entered its toughest five-game stretch of the year with road trips to Auburn, CAA leader UNC Wilmington and nationally-ranked Georgia. The Panthers fell at Auburn, and gave UNCW a tough battle as each game was settled in the last at-bat and State dropped a trio of one-run games. Leading 5-4 in the ninth against No. 7 Georgia, State was unable to hold onto the lead and lost on a walk-off homer.

The Panthers returned to their winning ways, as their offense exploded during a three-game sweep of North Carolina Central. In the second game against N.C. Central, Rochon-Salvas singled in the first inning to record his 244th career hit and eclipsed the school-record for hits established last season by Charlie Pelt.

Additionally, Palmer earned CAA Co-Pitcher of the Week (April 21) accolades after striking out a career-best 11 batters in a complete-game shutout against N.C. Central. Jonathan Kolowich was named CAA Rookie of the Week (April 21) as well, hitting .545 in four games with five RBIs and three runs scored.

The Panther bats stayed hot in a doubleheader against Alabama A&M, as Matt Van Horn belted four home runs on the day and two in each game of the sweep. State rallied for a ninth-inning victory against Savannah State and beat Hofstra in the series opener to extend its winning streak to seven games. The Panthers suffered a pair of setbacks against Hofstra and dropped two of three against Delaware before bouncing back with a doubleheader sweep against Presbyterian.

During its final home series, Georgia State retired the number of former head coach Mike Hurst. In a pregame ceremony on May 3, Hurst was presented with a framed jersey while his No. 30 was unveiled on the outfield wall. That number will never be worn by another Panther.

On April 29, Marc Mimeault was named to the prestigious Johnny Bench Award Watch List. He was one of 47 players named to the national watch list, earning the distinction as one of the country's best catchers.

Entering its second-to-last conference series on the road against Old Dominion, State scrapped to keep its CAA Tournament berth hopes alive. In the process, the Panthers recorded their 31st win of the season to tie the school record for victories set during the 2000 campaign. A road victory against Presbyterian gave the club the record outright.

After helping State to a series win over Old Dominion, Logan was named CAA Player of the Week on May 12. During the previous week, he hit .524 with a double, three home runs and 10 RBIs. He also drove in the game-winning runs in both victories over ODU.

Entering their final CAA series, the Panthers needed to win two of three games and hope for some help to earn one of six spots in the conference tournament. State won the opener and registered its 33rd win of the season, but dropped a one-run decision in the second game of the set.

On the final day of the season, State needed a win and a Northeastern loss to secure a spot in the CAA Tournament. After taking a 2-0 lead in the second, the Panthers were unable to hold on and fell 7-2 in the season finale. Northeastern dropped its game earlier in the day, so State would have secured a berth in the CAA Tourney with a win over Towson.

Despite the hard loss, the Panthers had several highlights to reflect upon. During the series against Towson, Bradley Logan set the single-season record for hits and finished the year with 85 – eight past the previous mark. Robinson Polanco recorded his eighth win of the season on Thursday, the most since Ronnie Robinson won nine in 2002.

Five Panthers – the most in school history – earned All-CAA honors. Designated hitter Derek Simmons was named First-Team All-CAA accolades after leading the team with a .379 average and a .475 on-base percentage. He also finished second on the club with 14 doubles and was a perfect 7-for-7 in stolen bases.

Logan, the only Panther to play and start in all 56 games, received second-team honors along with Rochon-Salvas. Logan hit .376 and led the team with 11 homers, 21 doubles and 63 RBIs. Rochon-Salvas hit .356 with 45 runs scored and swiped a career-high 14 bases.

Childers and Polanco rounded out the quintet, as the duo garnered home third-team recognition. Polanco led the pitching staff with an 8-4 record, including three complete games and struck out 71. Childers finished the year with a .319 average, 10 doubles, five homers and 33 RBIs.

Rochon-Salvas capped off the award season for the Panthers, taking home CAA Scholar-Athlete of the Year honors for the second straight season. The senior graduated with a degree in computer science and a 3.70 cumulative GPA. Additionally, he was honored as a national nominee for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, which recognizes outstanding student-athletes who complete their four years of eligibility.

The Panthers wrapped up the 2008 campaign with a 33-23 overall mark and a 12-17 record in the Colonial Athletic Association. State narrowly missed its third straight trip to the CAA Tournament after dropping its final game of the season, but a breakthrough season appears to have set the foundation for future success.
