Activities involving athletics evaluations and/or selection of prospective student-athletes.

Making telephone calls to prospective student-athletes (or prospective student-athletes' parents, legal guardians or coaches).



# Countable Coach



May receive complimentary tickets to home athletic contests only in the coach's sport.

May receive compensation for employment at an institution's sports camp or clinic.

May receive complimentary meals incidental to organized team activities (e.g., pre- or postgame meals, occasional meals, but not training table meals) or meals provided during a prospective student-athlete's official visit, provided the individual dines with the prospective student-athlete.



# Volunteer Coach



May not be provided additional compensation (in excess of the value of a full grant) for coaching duties performed during a vacation period.

May serve after exhausting athletic eligibility only if he or she has not yet completed his or her first bachelor's degree.

May receive a meal with a PSA during the PSA's official visit within a 30-mile radius of the institution's campus.



# Undergraduate Student Assistant



May be a current student-athlete (in his or her final year of intercollegiate eligibility) who is injured, and therefore has completed his or her intercollegiate participation, and may travel with the team for the remainder of the season.

May not provide instruction to student-athletes.

May participate in limited on-court or on-field activities during practice and games (e.g., shagging balls, assisting with drills, signaling in plays at the direction of a coach), along with traditional managerial functions.



# Manager



May keep stats during practice or competition.

May not attend an on or off-campus athletics event in the staff member's sport that involves prospective student-athletes. However, this rule does not apply to immediate family members or legal guardians of a participant, or to staff members whose duties are largely clerical in nature.

Is prohibited from participating in instructional activities with student-athletes and any on-court or on-field activities.



# **Non-Coaching Staff Member w/ Sport Specific Responsibilities**



No more than four (4) hours per day.  
Twenty (20) hours total per week.  
One (1) day “off” per week.



# CARAs within season



Eight (8) hours total per week with no more than two (2) spent on skill-related workouts).  
Two (2) days “off” per week.



# CARAs outside playing season



CHAMPS/Life skills or educational meetings;  
study hall, tutoring, and/or academic meetings;  
SAAC meetings.



# Non-Countable Activities



Two different exceptions to the day off per week  
legislation.



- 1. Preseason Practice Period**
- 2. Vacation Period**
- 3. Between Academic Terms**
- 4. Conference or Postseason  
Tournament**
- 5. NCAA Championship**



Meetings with coach, **initiated by student-athlete**,  
in which athletically-related activities take place.



# Countable Activity



Two different types of PSAs who may sign an NLI.

# Early Signing Period



NLIs can only be signed after what time on its  
issuance day?



**7 A.M. (local time)**



The time duration of an NLI.



**1-year contracts (completing the playing season does not fulfill the obligations of the NLI).**



Exception that allows coaches to hand deliver NLIs.



**None.**

**Coaches can never hand deliver  
or be with PSA off-campus at  
the time of signing.**



Date in which sports except WXC/WTK may begin unlimited phone calls.



# September 1 of PSA's Junior year.



Date which off-campus contact may begin.



**July 1 after PSA's Junior year.**

# Countable Activity



Permitted to pay actual and necessary expenses to attend a camp or clinic before initial FT collegiate enrollment.



**Outside Sponsor, including but  
not limited to, neighbor, team,  
business.**



Permissible expenses prior to the first permissible practice date for fall sports.



**Meals**  
**Lodging**  
**Entertainment**  
**Snacks**



**Institutions may pay for ACT/SAT scores to be sent to the EC for these PSAs.**



**PSAs who have signed an NLI,  
Financial Aid Agreement,  
written offer of admission, or  
submitted to the institution a  
financial deposit.**



This athletic department staff member may be employed at a coaching clinic sponsored by a recruiting or scouting service.



**No athletic department staff member may be employed (either salaried or a volunteer basis).**
